**Resolution of Support for the  
National Academy of Science's Institute of Medicine  
Recommendations on Reducing Underage Drinking**

**Whereas**, the National Academy of Science's Institute of Medicine has completed a year long study and issued its report "**Reducing Underage Drinking: A Collective Responsibility**" to Congress as requested, and;

**Whereas**, the annual social cost of underage drinking is estimated to be \$52.8 billion, and;

**Whereas**, the age of first drink has dropped to the age of 12 years, 11 months, and;

**Whereas**, children who consume alcohol before age 15 are four times more likely to develop addiction at some point in their lives, as well as suffer substantial brain damage, when compared to abstaining children, and;

**Whereas**, according to government surveys, 26% of California 11th graders report heavy drinking, defined as having five drinks of alcohol in a row in the past two weeks, and

**Whereas**, 23% of California 9th graders and 38% of California 11th graders have driven a car after drinking or been in a car driven by a friend after drinking, and

**Whereas**, independent research indicates that alcohol advertising and marketing have an impact on a child's beliefs and expectations regarding alcohol use, influencing children and their peers, and;

**Whereas**, in the Fresno, Los Angeles, Sacramento, San Diego and San Francisco media markets, just over 30% of all alcohol advertising on area television is more likely to be seen by youth than adults, and

**Whereas**, in addition to death and injuries from driving under the influence, youth alcohol problems are related to suicides and homicides, assaults, sexual violence, crime, poor school performance and family problems.

**Therefore, be it resolved** by the California Prevention Collaborative, that it supports the recommendations by the National Academy of Science's Institute of Medicine in its recent report, "Reducing Underage Drinking: A Collective Responsibility;" and;


That the California Prevention Collaborative and its statewide membership will advocate that the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs, the Department of Justice, the Department of Education, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, and other


related groups and agencies, implement in California the positive findings of this report that align with the mission and strategies of the California Prevention Collaborative.


